All clubs will be contacted via email 1 week before the carnival (Sunday 4th August 2024) to confirm their placement. If you do not receive a confirmation email, then we do not have your nomination and/or fee.

AGES: Under 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13/14, 15 years
(Under 13/14 & 15 will play 9 a side due to smaller than normal fields) Each team for U5-U12 to provide a game leader and game ball.

\$110 / team - U10 to U15 teams

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Perpetual Trophies

Mackay Wanderers Junior Carnival Perpetual Trophy

Non-competitive teams receive a point just for competing on the day which goes toward the competitive game points to determine which club wins the perpetual trophy.

March Past Trophy Winner

All teams are invited to be part of the March Past. Be creative and fly your club colours proudly.

Spirit of the Carnival/Fair Play Trophy

Awarded to the club who receives the most votes.

Each team will vote for the team (where team includes players, coach/manager and supporters at the game) they deem to have displayed the best sportsmanship, fair play & within the spirit of the game they have played for the day.

Points Format (Age Division Winners and Overall Club Trophy Winner)

Points towards the age champion and overall club trophy will be awarded on the following basis for U12 to U15 age divisions:

- 3 points for a Win
- 1 Point for a Draw
- 0 Points for a Loss

Plus 1 point per non-competitive side entered in the carnival will go towards club trophy points.

Prizes

- U5 - U8 will receive a participation ribbon. (These will be in Team Manager's kit collected at the beginning of the day)
- U9 - U11 will play for a Prize. (Each player in the winning team in each age group/pool will receive a prize. This will be awarded at Presentations at the end of the day)
- U12 - U15 will play for a Medallion. (Each player in the winning team in each age group will receive a medallion)

Mackay Wanderers Football Club are committed to fun activities for our Junior Players with the emphasis on participation and skills development.

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Carnival Rules

RULES: U5-11 as per Mini Roos rules & U12-U15 as per FIFA rules

**Only active players registered to your club on SQUADI will be allowed to participate in our Junior Carnival. This Carnival is approved Sanctioned Carnival, MWFC will be following all Football Queensland rules and regulations in regards to where players can play e.g. if they have not been assessed to play up/down then they will not be eligible to do so for the carnival either.

- All coaches/managers to hold Football Queensland Identification.
- Game Balls should be provided by each team on the day.
- All players taking the field of play MUST wear suitable footwear, shin pads and the official club colours in socks, shorts and shirts.
- No player will be allowed on the field with any hard brimmed hat, cap or visor (this is for safety reasons).
- All players should be encouraged to use suitable sun block during the day and stay hydrated.
- There is to be no scoring of non-competitive games as per Mini Roo rules (exception to the rule U9 - U11 where teams are playing for a prize).
- Each non-competitive team entered into carnival will receive 1 point toward the overall club trophy.
- Please keep children from playing in toilets, on the nets of the Cricket pitch and around food serving areas.
- NO glass, smoking or animals are allowed on Wanderers Sports Park.

The Number of players on the field are as follows -

U5-U7	4-a-side
U8-U9	7-a-side
U10-U13	9-a-side
U14/15	11-a-side

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Code Of Conduct

Children play sport for fun. Congratulate all players on their performance, regardless of who wins. Respect the official's decision. Remember – Referees and players make mistakes. The club official will be cautioned about their clubs players and spectators - should this be required.

All players, coaches, parents, spectators and volunteers participating in the carnival are to abide by the FFA Codes of Conduct.

If you have any concerns regarding an individual's behaviours during the day, please come to the Scorers' Room/Office in clubhouse for further action.

Injuries & First Aid

- When an injury occurs in a game the referee should react quickly and check that the player is not seriously hurt. This cannot happen without stopping the game in some circumstances, but if there is any possibility of danger to any player, the referee must stop the game. The referee may instruct the coach/manager to approach the injured player and the coach/manager may then also request the presence of the players' parent/guardian.
- At no time is it advised to pick up a player from the field if that player cannot stand up without help. The only person who should be allowed to carry a player off the field is a parent, guardian or ambulance officer.
- If time is lost due to an injury, no extra time can be played due to the tight schedule of the games.
- The Coach/Manager must complete an Incident Report Form for all injuries that occur during the game. These are available from the Scorers Room/Office. All injured players/parents/guardians are advised to seek further information from the Football Qld website if there is the possibility of a future Insurance Claim as soon as possible after the incident. A delay in pursuing this information may deem any application invalid.
- Please go to scorers/office room for First Aid Officer located in clubhouse.
- If an Ambulance is required, please notify the personnel in the Scorers Room/Office in clubhouse.
- Ice can be obtained from the Clubhouse for First Aid. Freezer will be located between the change rooms in the toilet block.

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To help the day run smoothly!

- The Draw for games during the day **will not** be able to be provided to teams or clubs prior to the day. All Draws will be available in the Team Manager's information kits. Last minute team withdrawals have a **HUGE** impact on a **fair and accurate** game draw for the relevant age groups.
- Team Manager's information kits will be available for collection by Team Coach/Manager Mackay Wanderers Football Club representatives available to answer any questions to clarify any information. See Schedule of the day for times for collection.
- Managers, Coaches and Parent Volunteers for Mackay Wanderers Football Club will be available around the Grounds to assist or direct enquiries to the appropriate Official for the Club.
- During the Carnival, we will ensure that catering is accommodated for all that are attending. Please be patient when waiting to order or collect food/drinks.
- Amenities (Toilets) – we will endeavour to keep the toilets tidy and resourced during the day. If you notice the toilets needing restocking/cleaning please let one of our Volunteers in the Canteen know.
